Did you know that more than 2,500 men, women and children are homeless in Central Arkansas every night? Homelessness is everywhere. Become part of the solution. Help the homeless in Little Rock, Central Arkansas, and ultimately across America by participating in **NIGHT ON THE STREET!**

On March 16th, 2020, Union Rescue Mission will host the 14th **Annual Night on the Street** at Little Rock's War Memorial Stadium. Join people from all over Central Arkansas from 5:00-9:00 pm to raise awareness of homelessness and support to help the Union Rescue Mission continue to provide shelter, services, and recovery opportunities to those without a home.

Night on the Street participants are asked to call friends, family, and coworkers to pledge a donation. Each participant will fill out pledge cards with the donor's information and will be provided the payment link on the URM website to give to donors. All donations go to helping the homeless at Union Rescue Mission's Nehemiah & Dorcas Houses.

Most homelessness is a result of domestic violence, addiction, or mental illness. The Union Rescue Mission's Nehemiah & Dorcas Houses have programs to minister to ALL of these root causes!
